There are so many factors that play a part within the economic climate, a huge player are these right wing governments and their policies and agreements. In bed with these governments are the movers and shakers of the Global economy and the so-called free market capitalists. I can give you the most recent example of how this system works well for a global company called Caterpillar.

I was in London, Ontario on January 21st along with 15,000 other demonstrators in Victoria Park to support our Sisters and Brothers of Local 27, who were locked out on January 1st by these overstuffed fat cats a company called Caterpillar.

In 2008 Harper visited this plant to hand out a 5 million dollar tax break. It was an obvious showcase for Prime Minister Harper regarding corporate tax breaks.
